You've sent out your package, and you have a meeting with an agent. It is important to remember that this is a partnership. After you've gone through a bit of small talk and maybe even a bit of the business talk it's time for some important business questions. These can also be interwoven into your conversation.

You've got to go by your own feelings in this.

You:

What are my goals :

1. How's business for you this year?
2. Do you get much call for people in my category?
3. How often do they get out? (those in your category)
4. Are they booking frequently?
5. Would you say that most film/tv casting directors see your actors?
6. Are some casting directors that are difficult to get in the door with?
7. (This is a question that is asked if the meeting or call has gone supremely well and you feel like this agent is a real candidate for you) ... What is the best way for us to communicate should we start working together, what medium: phone, text, or email?
8. And, should audition activity get very slow I want to be able to reach out to discuss, is that okay with you?

Your goal is to have a strong relationship so these questions help you both towards that goal.
